

UPDATE ON TAX RETURN PREPARER REGISTRATION

All Paid Tax Return Preparers are currently required to:

- A) Obtain a PTIN starting 9/1/10 thru 12/31/10 by registering with IRS.
- B) Reactivate a PTIN starting 9/1/10 thru 12/31/10 by registering with IRS.
- C) There will be a fee to register
 - 1) Not determined but estimated to be \$100.00 to \$200.00.
 - 2) Since Attorney, CPA, EA & PA already pay a registration fee; they may be entitled to a refund.
- D) PSPA recommends all preparers register from 9/1/10 to 12/31/10 (even if the regulations change to loosen up this requirement).
- E) Competency Test expected to be available starting in April, 2011.
 - 1) Every preparer registered with IRS must take and pass test except Attorneys, CPA's EA's and PA's.
 - 2) PSPA is in talks with a Provider to teach a course to assist in preparing for the competency exam. (Both Parts)
 - 3) Competency Exam is 2 parts:
 - a) Individual tax and
 - b) Business tax (Sch C or Sch E)

Not sure if there is a separate fee to take exam
but there might be.

 - 4) Registrations will be required to be updated every so many years (We think it may be every 3 years).
- F) Who is a Paid Tax Return Preparer who is required to register and get a PTIN?
 - Anyone who signs a return.
 - Anyone who is involved with a substantial part of return.
 - Factor to Consider
 - 1) Complexity of work performed.
 - 2) The amount of Income, Deduction or Loss
 - 3) While the above factors should be considered, it is not limited to those factors.
